

LOWER POTTS GROVE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
Special Meeting
September 17, 2008

The Board of Commissioners of Lower Pottsgrove Township held a special meeting on Wednesday, September 17, 2008 at the Lower Pottsgrove Township Municipal Building, 2199 Buchert Road, Pottstown, Pennsylvania. Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. The following attended: Commissioners Bruce Foltz, ~~Jonathan Spadt~~, Stephen Klotz, James Phillips and Anthony Doyle; Solicitor R. Kurtz Holloway; Rodney P. Representatives of Delta Development Group, Inc., a consulting firm that offers services in community and economic planning, information technology, and real estate development and transportation services to public and private sector clients, delivered a presentation to the Board of Commissioners. Delta's proposal focused on contracting with Lower Pottsgrove Township to secure federal and state grant money to fund future improvements at the Sanatoga Interchange area of the Township.


A question and answer session followed the presentation. The Board took no action this time.

The Township has been receiving calls on the timing of the traffic light at this intersection. After investigating the matter, Township staff has determined that the light is in good working order and is in accordance with the PennDOT timing for that traffic signal.
