

A motion was made by Mr. Troutman, seconded by Mr. Cimino, and unanimously approved by a 5-0 vote to allow the Save Sunnybrook group to set up an information table and to support the three different collections for soldiers, local needy, and pets at this summer's events.

II. *Vendor Permit Application*

Ms. Elliott said she sent the vendor permit to the Township Solicitor to review. He commented that he was not sure whether the PRC had the authority to grant permits. She said this could be remedied by developing an ordinance granting the PRC this authority. She and the Solicitor will look into this and report back to the PRC. Members of the PRC agreed with the changes Ms. Elliott made to the permit.

There was also discussion on whether vendors who sold their wares at sporting events not sponsored by the Township would be required to apply for a permit and how it would impact the income of sports organizations. The PRC agreed to discuss this at their next meeting.

III. *Sports Organization Meeting*

Ms. Elliott asked the PRC members for information about PRC member availability and the sports organization schedules in June. Everyone was generally available at the end of June. Ms. Elliott said she would prepare an agenda and contact everyone for available dates.

NEW BUSINESS

I. *Playground Grant*

Ms. Elliott said she was sent information about a grant for playground equipment. She asked the PRC for their opinion on putting play equipment at Gerald Richards Park. There was discussion on several possible locations.

A motion was made by Mr. Cimino, seconded by Mr. Wood, and unanimously approved to apply for a grant to install playground equipment in Gerald Richards Park.

II. *Vice Chair Election*

A motion was made by Mr. Wood, seconded by Mr. Cimino, and approved by a 4-0 vote, with Mr. Troutman abstaining from the vote.

Mr. Wood left the meeting at 6:42 p.m., just after reporting that the eight people who turfed the fields at Gerald Richards Park were ordered to pay approximately \$110 each by the District Justice to pay for repairs to the damaged fields. He said he was happy with the result. Members of the PRC agreed.

III. *Summer Meeting Schedule*

A motion was made by Mr. Troutman, seconded by Mr. Cimino, and unanimously approved by a 4-0 vote to cancel the June, July, and August meetings of the PRC, unless there was a need to conduct business.

IV. *PRC Member Park Tour*

There being no other business, a motion was made by Ms. Abdalla, seconded by Mr. Troutman, and unanimously approved by a 4-0 vote to adjourn the business portion of the meeting at 6:47 p.m. so the park members could conduct their annual tour of the Township's parks.
